

## **STUDENT RIGHT TO KNOW**

The student Right-to-know Act (Publ. 105-18) requires schools to disclose information about graduation rates to current and prospective students and the public. The Right-to-know regulations defines the reporting period to be based on starting July 1<sup>st</sup> and ending June 30<sup>th</sup> of each year.

Associated Technical College, Los Angeles, in complying with the Students right-to-know Act, discloses the following graduation rates for the enrollment period of July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018 for the Medical Assistant and Telecommunications programs.

The school enrolled **Two Hundred and Twenty Five (225 = 100%)** in its Medical Assistant program. **One Hundred and Fifty Two (152 = 68%)** students completed their training within 150% of the normal time to graduate. The remaining **Eighty Three (83)** students either did not graduate or did not complete within the 150% of the normal time to graduate.

The school also enrolled **One Hundred and Two (102 = 100%)** students in its Telecommunications program. **Sixty Three (63 = 62%)** completed their training within 150% of the normal time to graduate. The remaining **Thirty Nine (39)** students either did not graduate or did not complete within the 150% of the normal time to graduate.
